PETITION FOR PROBATE AND LETTERS
TESTAMENTARY

The Petition of Lillian F. Quigley, also known as Lillian Fox Quigley, respectfully represents:

1. That she is a citizen of the United States and a resident of Montgomery County, Maryland, of adult age and not under any legal disability, and she makes this application as the Executrix nominated in the Will of the above named decedent.

2. That William Carroll Quigley, also known as Carroll Quigley, late an adult citizen of the United States, domiciled in the District of Columbia, died on the third day of January, 1977, leaving a paper in the nature of a Last Will and Testament bearing date June 7, 1960, in which this Petitioner is named as Executrix, and which Will is now on file in the Office of the Register of Wills for the District of Columbia; that the decedent also left a paper entitled "First Codicil of William Carroll Quigley," dated August 15, 1963, which paper does not amend or modify the nomination of this Petitioner as Executrix; that decedent also left a paper writing entitled "The Last Will and Testament of Carroll Quigley of Washington, D.C.," dated April 16, 1973, which names no Executor and makes no disposition of the residue of his estate but merely supplements the paper writing dated June 7, 1960, and

the first codicil thereto dated August 15, 1963, by a specific bequest to one Helen Veit; that no other paper in the nature of a testamentary disposition of the decedent's estate has been found, although search has been made, and this Petitioner believes that the above mentioned paper dated June 7, 1960 is in fact the Last Will and Testament of said decedent and the paper writing dated August 15, 1963 is the first codicil to said paper writing dated June 7, 1960 and that the paper writing dated April 16, 1973 is in fact a second codicil to the said paper writing dated June 7, 1960. Testator was survived by the following persons who are his only heirs at law next of kin, namely, by this Petitioner, Lillian Fox Quigley, also known as Lillian F. Quigley, his widow, and by Denis Carroll Quigley, an adult son who resides at 5112 Saratoga Avenue, Bethesda, Maryland 20016 and Thomas Fox Quigley, an adult son who resides at 2841 Hunter Road, Fairfax, Virginia 22030.

3. At the time of his death, said Testator was not seized of any real estate in the District of Columbia or elsewhere other than one parcel of real estate in the District of Columbia which was owned by him and his surviving widow, the Petitioner, Lillian F. Quigley, as tenants by the entireties, said property being described as 4448 Greenwich Parkway, N.W., Washington, D.C., and also known as Lot 0202 Square 1351 which was assessed by the District of Columbia for fiscal year 1977 in the amount of \$69,263.00.

4. Said Testator was possessed at the time of his death of personal property of a total estimated value of \$12,184.13 consisting of cash on deposit in banks of \$4,334.13, traveler's checks, \$50.00, two automobiles of the estimated value of \$1,000.00,

books and periodicals of the estimated value of \$6,790.00.

5. The debts of the decedent consist principally of his funeral expenses in the amount of \$617.00. The District of Columbia Inheritance Taxes including the taxes on the jointly owned real estate in the District of Columbia are estimated to be \$2,200.00., \$1,916.83 of which has been paid.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays:

1. That notice by citation or by publication or by both as may be necessary shall issue directed to the above named heirs at law next of kin.

2. That said paper writing dated June 7, 1960, the first codicil thereto dated August 15, 1963 and the paper writing entitled "The Last Will and Testament of Carroll Quigley of Washington, D.C.," dated April 16, 1973 be admitted to probate and record as the Last Will and Testament of the said William Carroll Quigley, deceased, as a Will and Codicils thereto of both real and personal property.

3. That Letters Testamentary issued to this Petitioner as the Executrix named in said Will and Codicils thereto, and

For such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require and to this Honorable Court shall seem proper.
